General Discussion Points

• The RSC provided an update on the Regional Group Model, Advisory Board elections and the Schools White Paper.

Converter Academy Orders

Points discussed in relation to school conversion.

Project: Discussion to consider Bowling Park Primary School, Bradford, to convert and join Exceed Academies Trust.

AB discussion:

- The board agreed that this sets a good example of a strong converter school joining a well-established Bradford based trust.
- The board also noted the geographical placement of this school in comparison to the existing schools in the trust align well.
- No concerns raised by the board.

RSC decision: Approved

Further actions required: Project lead to inform Trust and DCS of decision and Academy Order to be sent.

Project: Discussion to consider Miriam Lord Community Primary School, Bradford, to convert and join The Priestley Academy Trust

AB discussion:

- The board suggested that the trust use this time to review schemes of delegation and school improvement.
- No concerns raised by the board.

RSC decision: Approved

- SRMA to be deployed to help provide further support.

- The board agreed to the following conditions:
 - Provide clarity on the composition of the trust board in its new structure
 - Manage the trust's expectations regarding its growth strategy
 - SRMA deployment to support the trust's understanding of its own potential growth
