Thank you for your email of 23 May 2022 requesting the following information:

'I purchased an EX MOD Land Rover 110 - would it be possible to have a copy of the FULL service records and the vehicles entire history with you including which regiment it served in?

## The Chassis number is SALLDRAC7BA280654 It's a 3 Door Land Rover 110'

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that, using the chassis number you have supplied, no information in scope of your request is held.

Under Section 16 (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that we are only able to search the Joint Asset Management and Engineering Solutions with a military equipment registration mark. We are often able to establish this using the chassis number, but unfortunately not in this case. If you are able to locate the black vehicle military plate on your vehicle and supply a photograph of it or the details on it, we may be able to do a further search.

Alternatively, you may wish to contact the Royal Logistic Corps Museum who might be able to assist your research further. The contact details for the museum are below. It is, however, possible that the Museum may charge to use its services.
