Background

On 1 April 2014 and 12 May 2014 we issued Work Programme Live Running Memos no 149 and 153 respectively, introducing version 2 of the Performance Management Regime guidance which included a requirement for providers to produce monthly Management Information (MI) regarding the performance of Supply Chain partners and how their performance contributes to overall performance.

Following a review of the MI we received from yourselves, it has been acknowledged that Supply Chain MI is being supplied to DWP Performance Managers through Provider Action Plan updates, and this is seen as a more effective way of obtaining and monitoring up to date information.

Summary and action

With immediate effect, the monthly Annex 3 Supply Chain MI return introduced in Work Programme Live Running Memos no. 149 and 153 are no longer required and Providers can stop sending the return into the Department.

Providers should, however, continue to supply the Action Plan updates MI previously agreed with their Performance Manager.

The Work Programme Provider Guidance is currently being updated to reflect this change.
