Background	
When a Job Outcome or Sustained Job Outcome claim that includes a period of UC is going to be input to PRaP, Providers are currently required to notify PPVT the day before they submit the claim by sending an e-mail to the PPVT e-mail account (PPVT.SHEFFIELD@DWP.GSI.GOV.UK.).	
This notification enables PPVT to accurately identify claims which include a period of UC so that the correct validation methodology and criteria can be applied.	
From 22 ^d December 2014 this process will change; instead of sending e-mail notifications, Providers should prefix the Employers Name in the Employment Details screen of PRaP with 'Uni Cred'.	

This will remove the need to send separate notifications and thus reduce your administrative burden for these claims, but still allow our Validation Teams to identify them and apply the correct validation criteria. Conversely failure to input this prefix will of course make it impossible for us to identify them

Summary and action

Providers to note that (From 22 December 2014) they should no longer send e-mail notifications to PPVT when submitting claims with UC interest.

Instead from 22 December 2014 providers are required to enter the prefix 'Uni Cred' in the Employer Name Field of the Employment Details screen on PRaP before submitting any Job Outcome or Sustainment Outcome claim.

If more than one employer is recorded during the period of claim providers will need to enter this prefix in each of the Employment Details screens.

The Generic Provider Guidance (Chapter 5) is currently being updated to reflect this change.
