## JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's employer was the First Respondent 6Cats UK Limited (in liquidation) (company number 07284675), based on his January 2014 written contract of employment with CXC Contracting Limited, the letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 2016 which told him that his employer (CXC Contracting Limited) was changing its name to 6Cats (UK) Limited with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 and his subsequent payslips. His remaining claims for notice pay, holiday pay, outstanding wages, redundancy payment and unfair dismissal therefore proceed against the First Respondent only.
2. The Claimant withdrew his claim against the Third Respondent in its entirety at this hearing and that claim is therefore dismissed on withdrawal.
3. To the extent that the Claimant had also brought a claim against the Second Respondent (6Cats International Limited), that claim is dismissed as it was not his employer and is not therefore the correct respondent.
