

## Permitting decisions- Surrender

---

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for **Rea Farm** operated by **Mrs Bridget Marshall, Mr Simon Hart and Mr Dimitri Harrison**.

The permit number is **EPR/BP3638ZN**.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state. We consider in reaching this decision that we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

### Key issues of the decision

This full surrender is for a broiler poultry farm installation that was never built as the relevant planning permission was not obtained.

### Decision considerations

#### Confidential information

A claim for commercial or industrial confidentiality has not been made.

The decision was taken in accordance with our guidance on confidentiality.

## **Pollution risk**

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility. The farm was never built or operated and hence no pollution risks.

## **Satisfactory state**

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state, having regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation.
