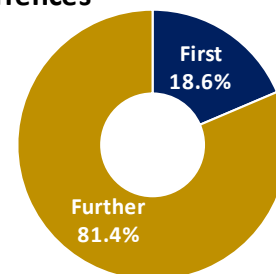
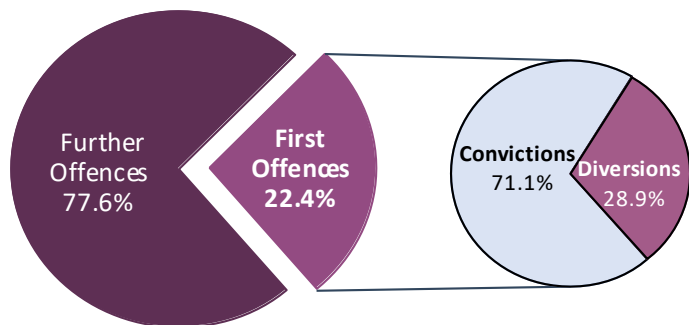


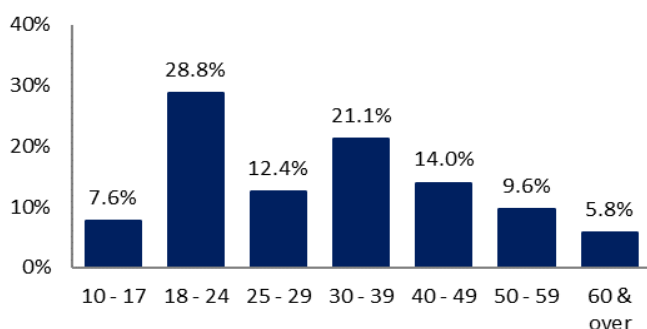
21,437 cases were dealt with by conviction or diversion in the justice system, with **4,799** of these being **first offences (22.4%)**

18.6% of all convictions were for first offences

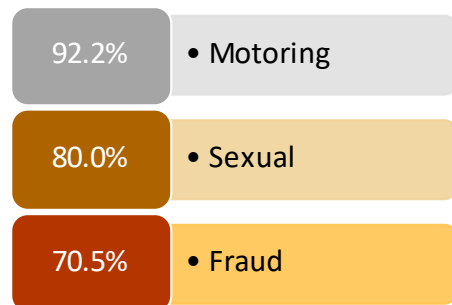


2020-21 at a glance

18 - 24 year olds make up just over a quarter (**28.8%**) of first time entrants

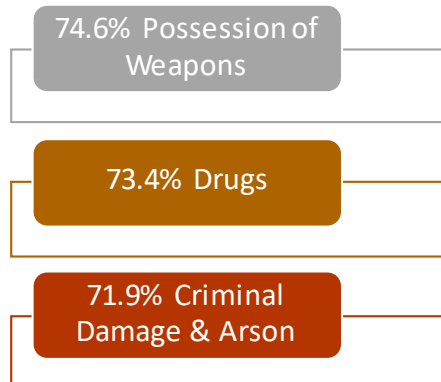


Convictions
