You will leave hospital when:



 you do not need hospital care



 you can get the right care outside hospital.



Your health team will decide when you leave.





stay safe



get the right care.



In most cases, you will go home.



That might be a **care home**, if that is where you live.

When you go home you may need care and support:



• to get dressed



to wash



• to do shopping.



If you need more help, you may need to go to another place of care to get better before you go home.

What can I expect?



Soon after you arrive in hospital, someone will talk to you about:



 how you will be able to leave hospital



 what day you might leave hospital



• what matters most to you.



A family member, friend or carer can join you for this talk.



Questions to ask during your hospital stay:



1. Why am I in hospital?



2. What is going to happen to me today and tomorrow?



3. What help might I need when I leave hospital?



4. When will I be able to leave hospital?
