## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: TOOL THEFTS.

We refer to your email dated 12 August 2021 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

- 1)The number of tool theft and construction machine theft incidents from construction sites which have been reported, along with the value of the tools/machines and the quantity of the tools/machines that have been stolen. This should also be broken down into the type of tool (hand-powered tool, diggers or other vehicles etc), and should be provided for the last three years up to the date of your reply to this email.
- 2) The number of incidences of construction material theft which have been reported to you, which should include the exact materials which were reported stolen (eg steel, cement, plastics etc). This should be provided for the last three years up to the date of your reply to this email.

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

1)The number of tool theft and construction machine theft incidents from construction sites which have been reported, along with the value of the tools/machines and the quantity of the tools/machines that have been stolen.
