Amendment to Transport for London Settlement Letter

As part of the funding settlement letter of 25 February 2022, you agreed to complete an Equalities Impact Assessment where necessary on your chosen new revenue options by 29 April 2022.

On 21 March 2022, your officials informed us that this deliverable would be delayed. Our Ministers have considered this, and I can confirm that we are to content to amend the date contained in Annex A (para. 7b, deliverable 3) from 29 April to 27 May 2022. This has been amended on the basis that the Mayor of London will commence public consultation on proposals where necessary by 27 May 2022, as agreed in the latest settlement letter.
