How many accidents involving electric / e-scooters have taken place in your area between 01 January 2019 and 01 December 2021.

Do you have further details of the number of accidents involving e-scooter collisions with motor vehicles e.g. cars, buses and vans.

Please can you provide the figures on a month-by-month basis for this time period.

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

How many accidents involving electric / e-scooters have taken place in your area between 01 January 2019 and 01 December 2021.

01 January 2021 – 03 August 2021 – Not available see note below September 2021 – No information held October 2021 – 1 Incident November 2021 – No information held

December 2021 - No information held

Please note that due to a technical fault, we are unable to perform historical searches before 3rd August 2021.

Do you have further details of the number of accidents involving e-scooter collisions with motor vehicles e.g. cars, buses and vans.

Electric scooter ran a red light and collided with a motor vehicle, No injuries reported. Details exchanged by both parties.
