JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

20 The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- (1) The claim for a statutory redundancy payment is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £969.21 less any deductions for tax and national insurance.
- (2) The claim for breach of contract (notice pay) was lodged out of time. The
 25 Tribunal is not prepared to exercise its discretion to hear this claim out of time.
