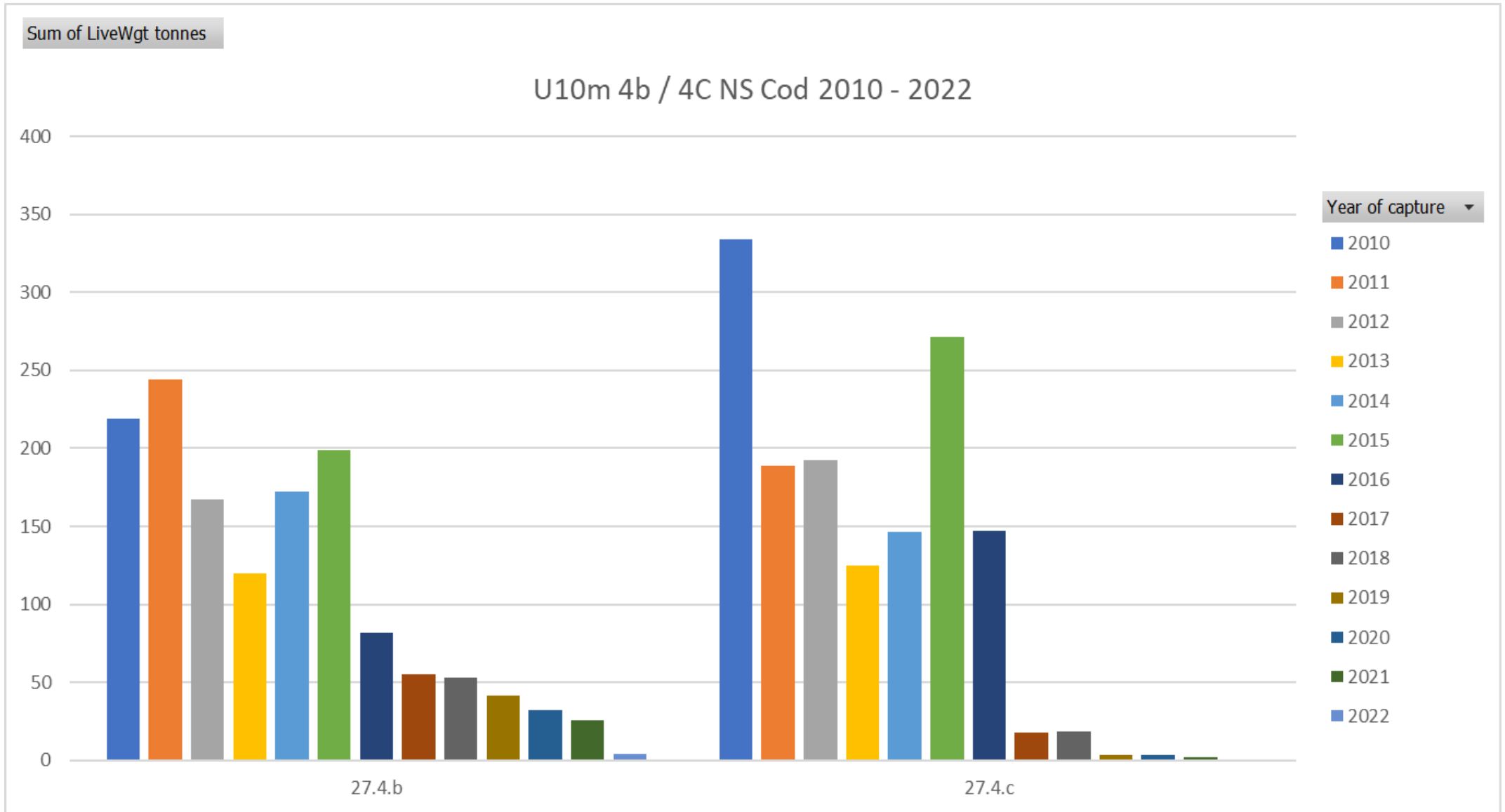

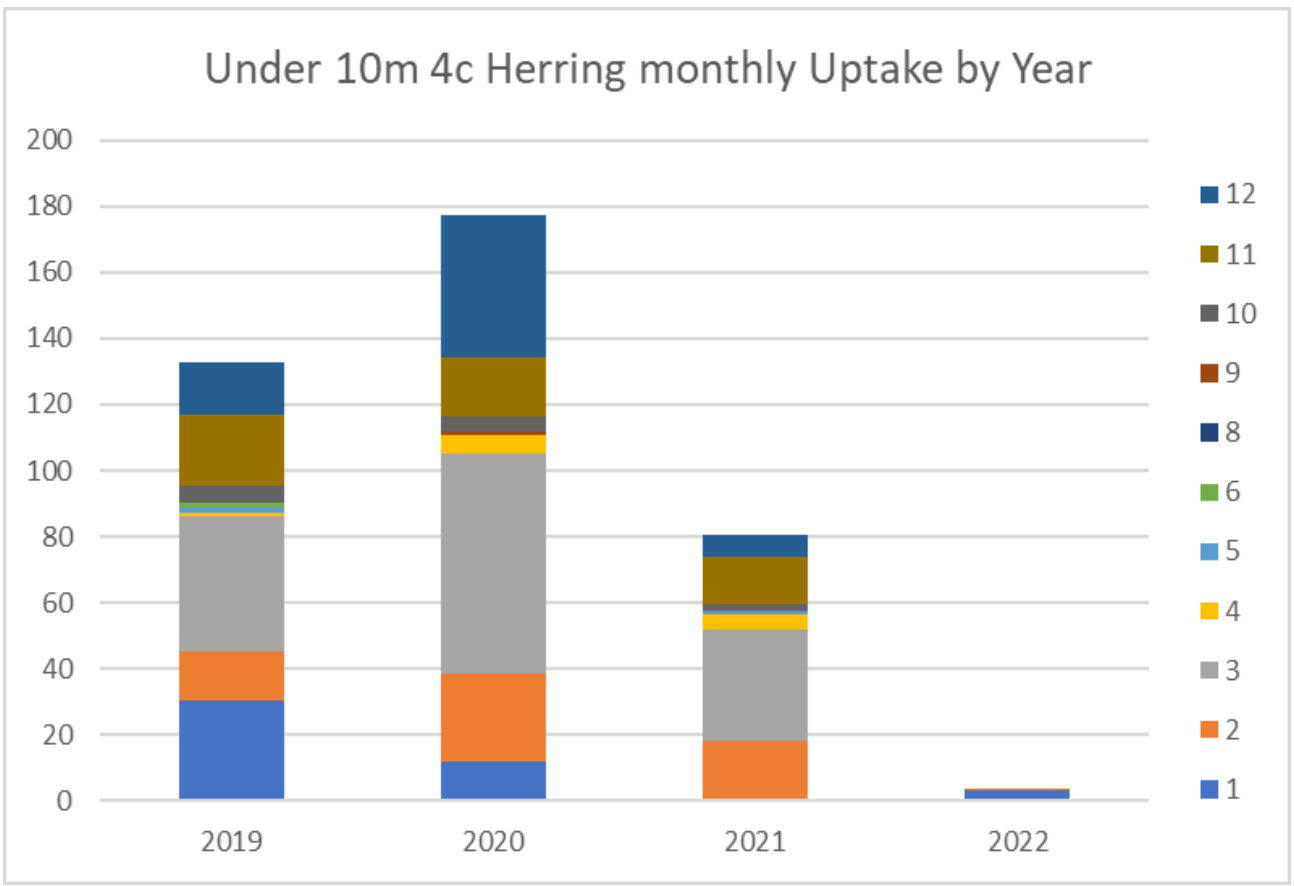
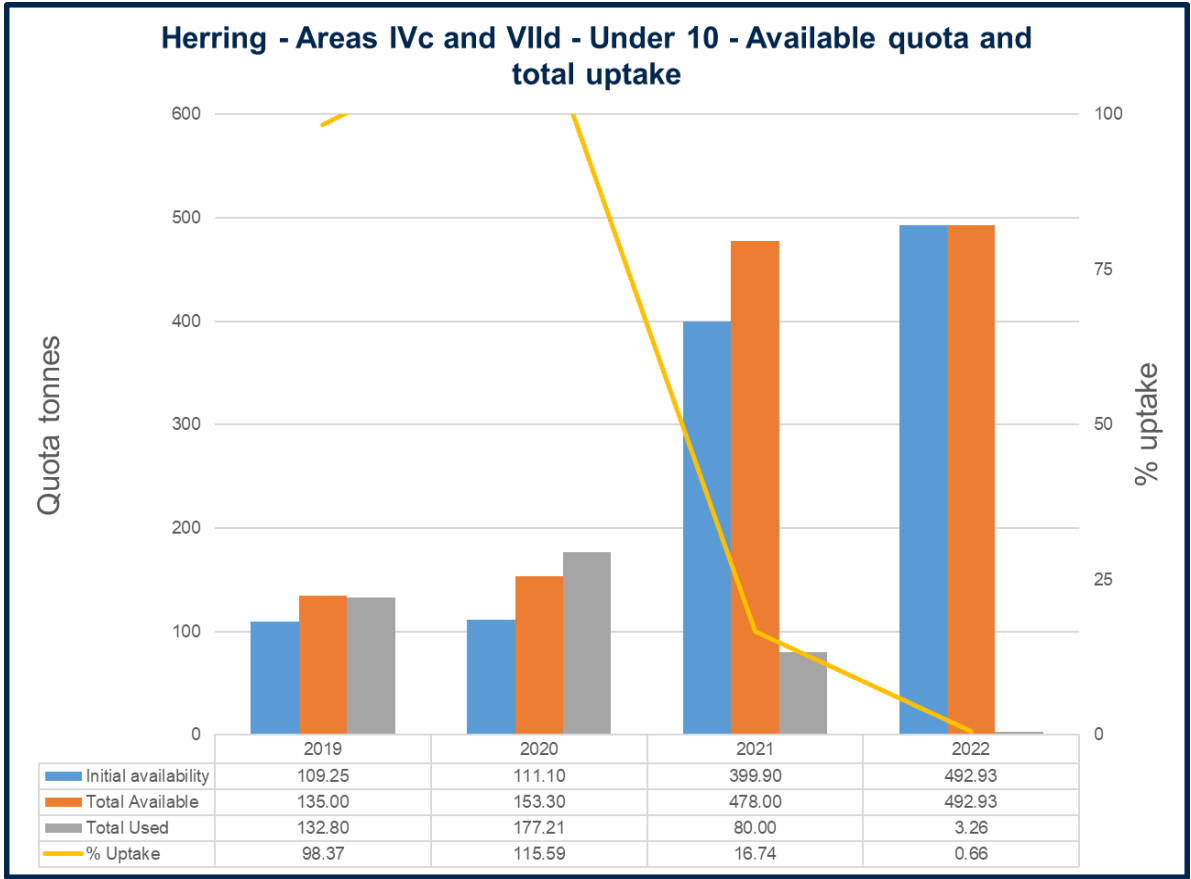

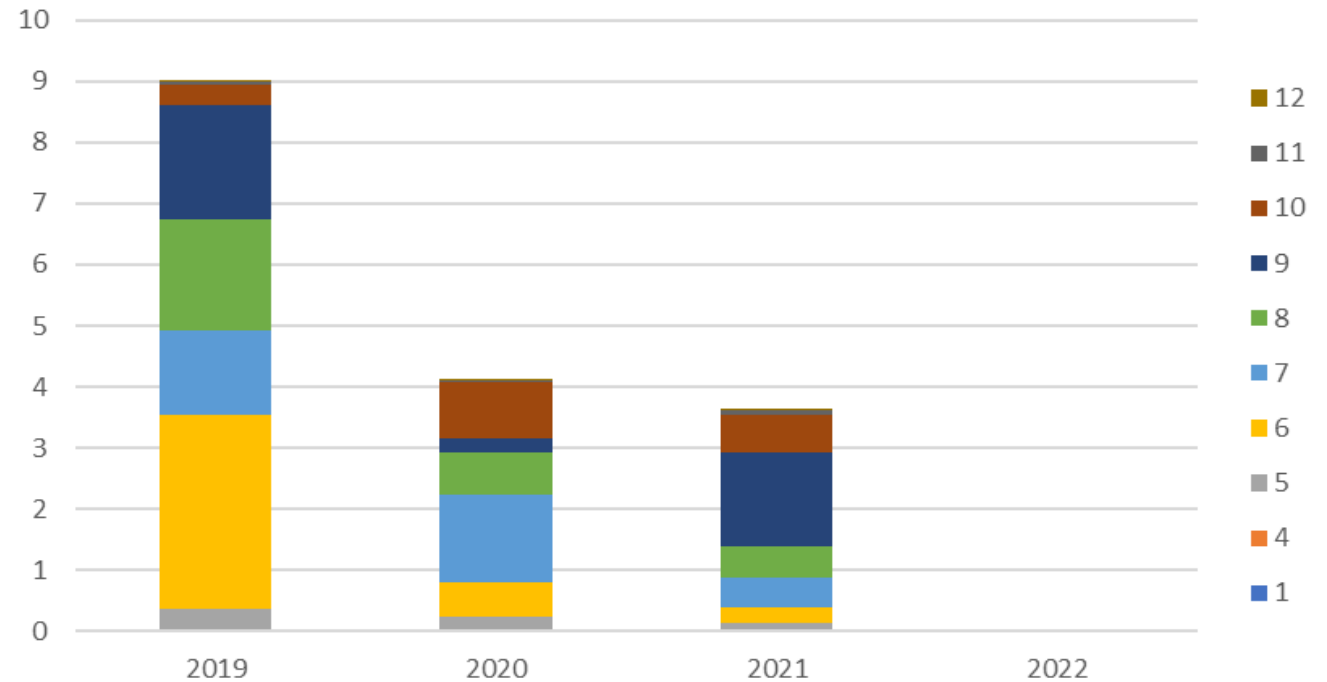

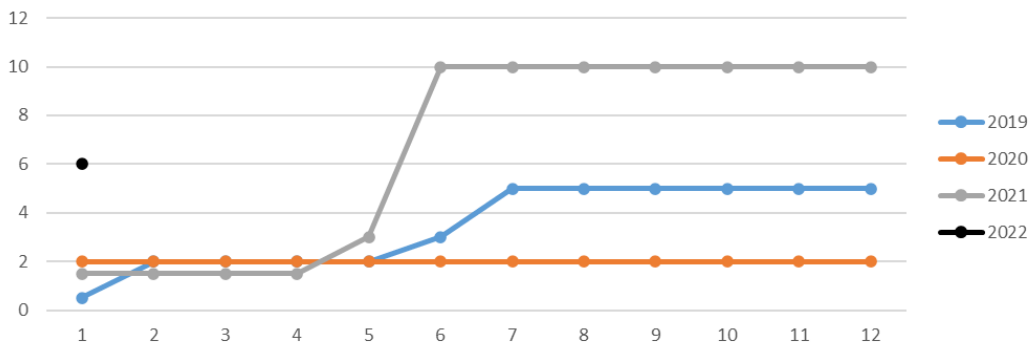
Mackerel - North Sea - Under 10 - Available quota and total uptake

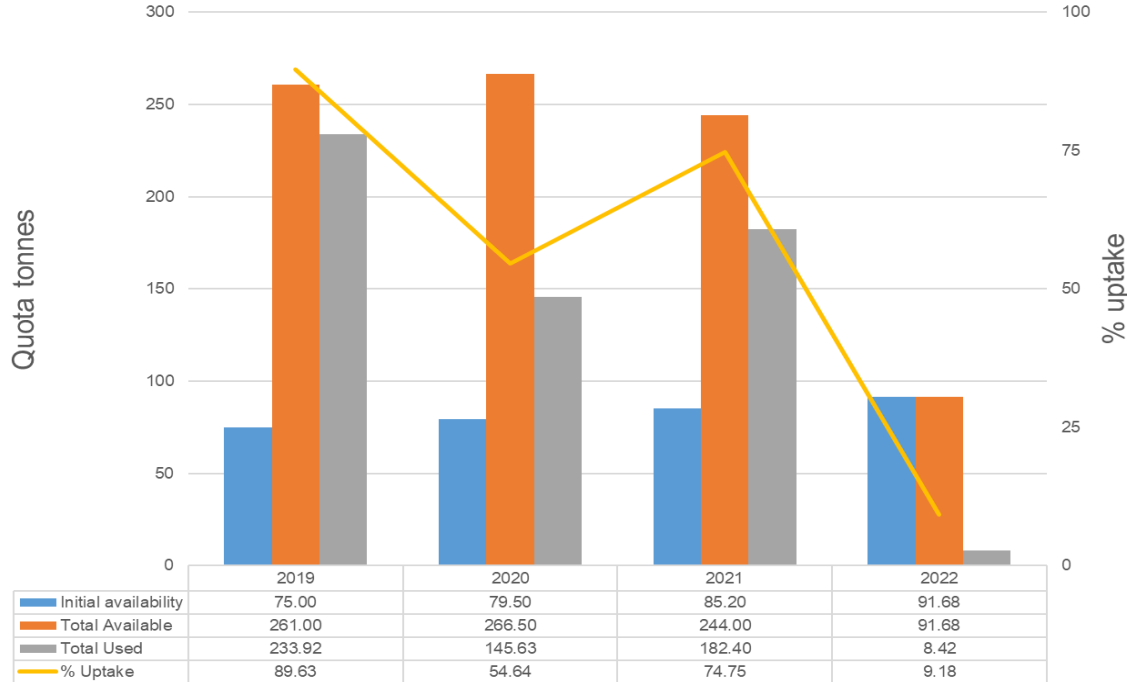

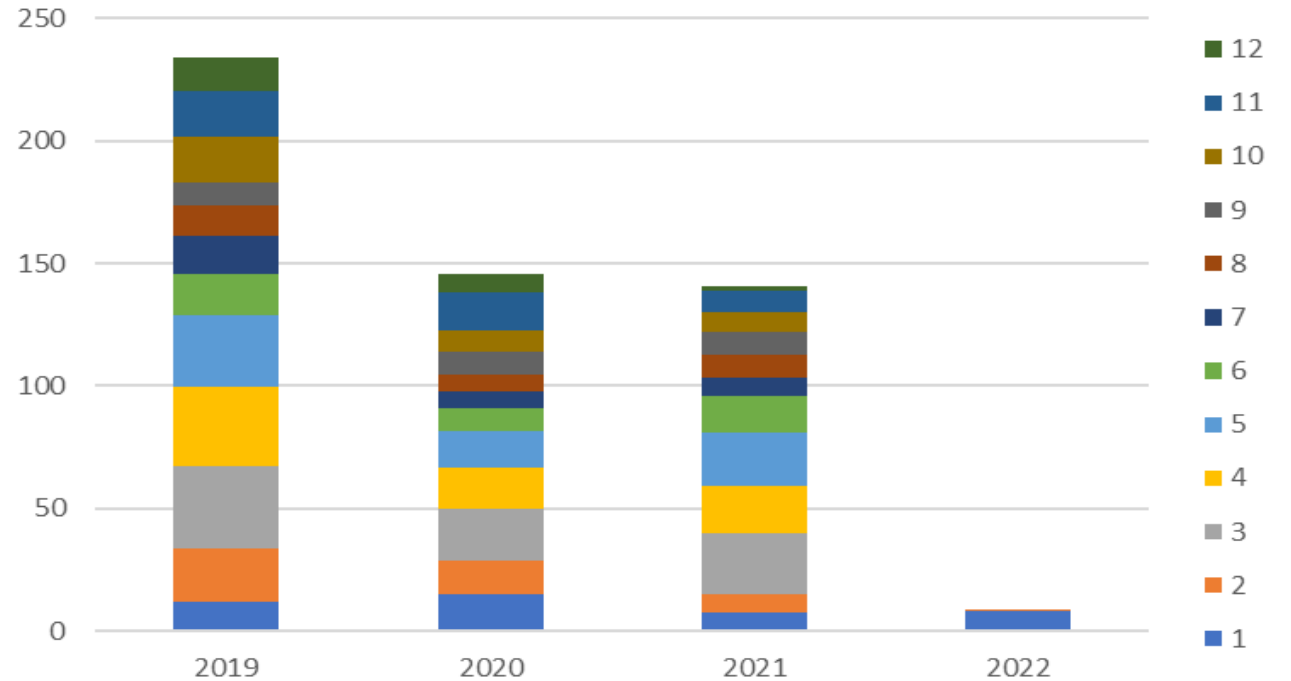

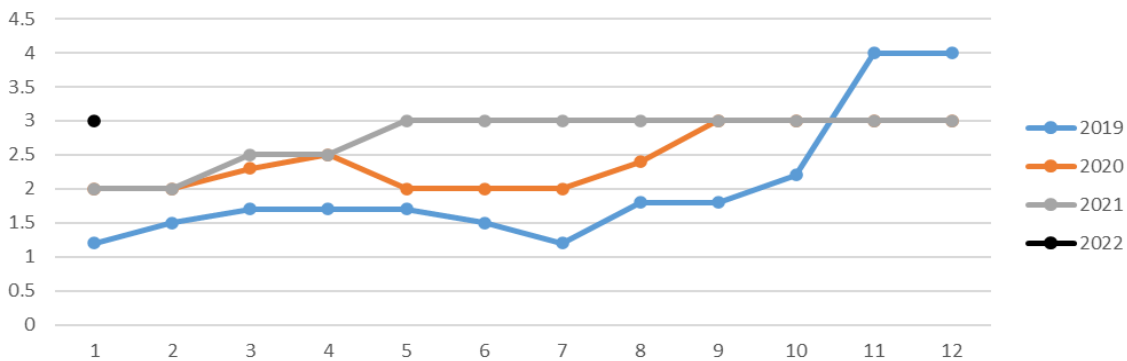
Skates and rays - North Sea - Under 10 - Available quota and total uptake

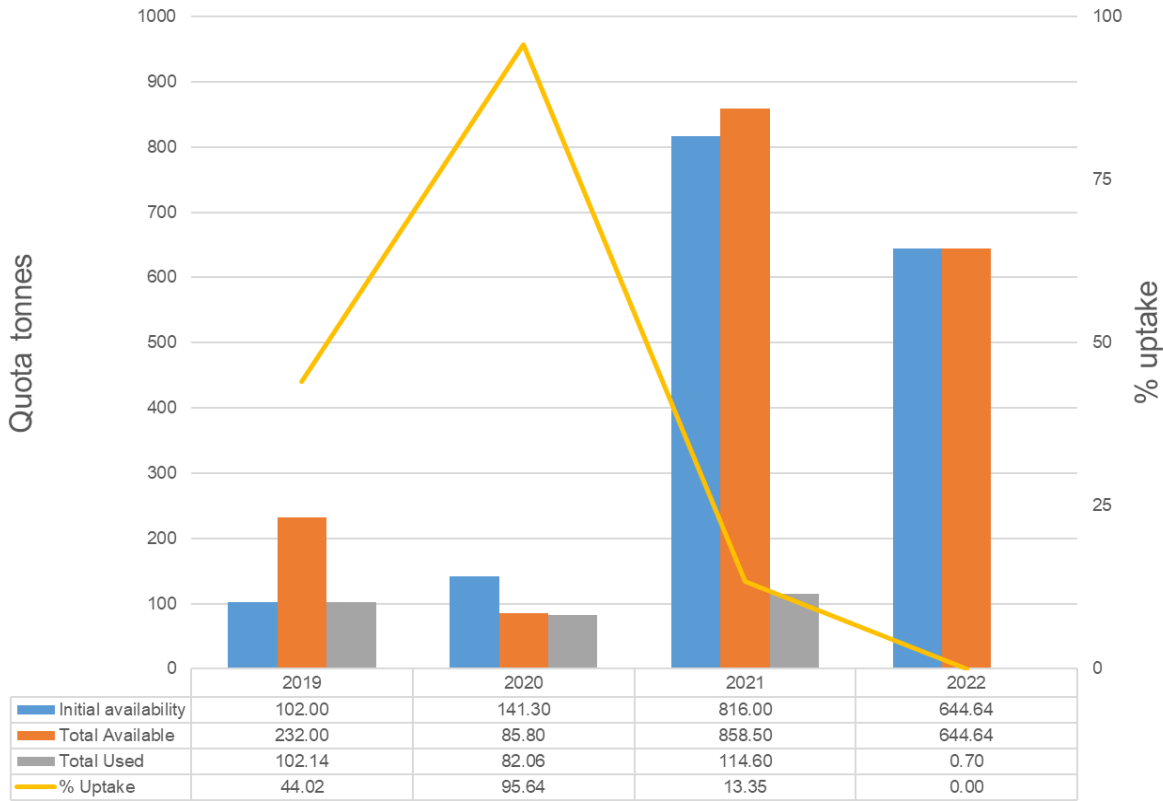

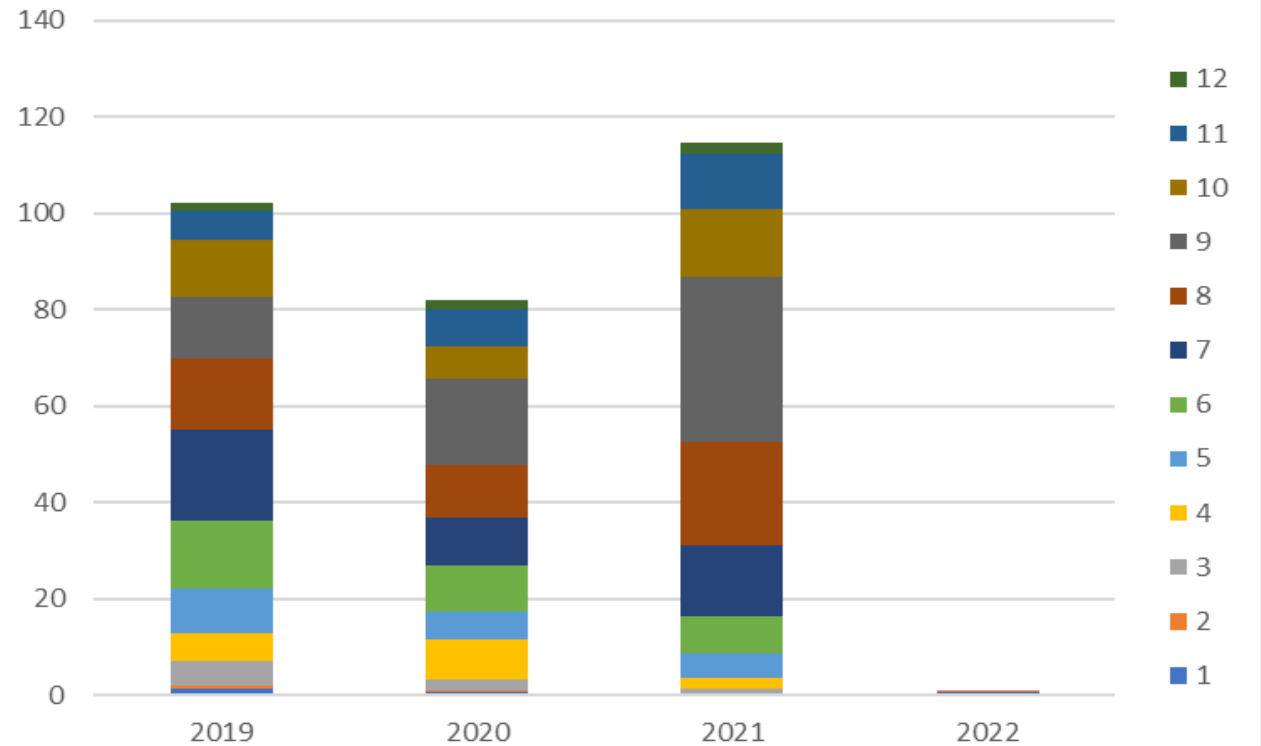

Under 10m NS Sole monthly Uptake by Year



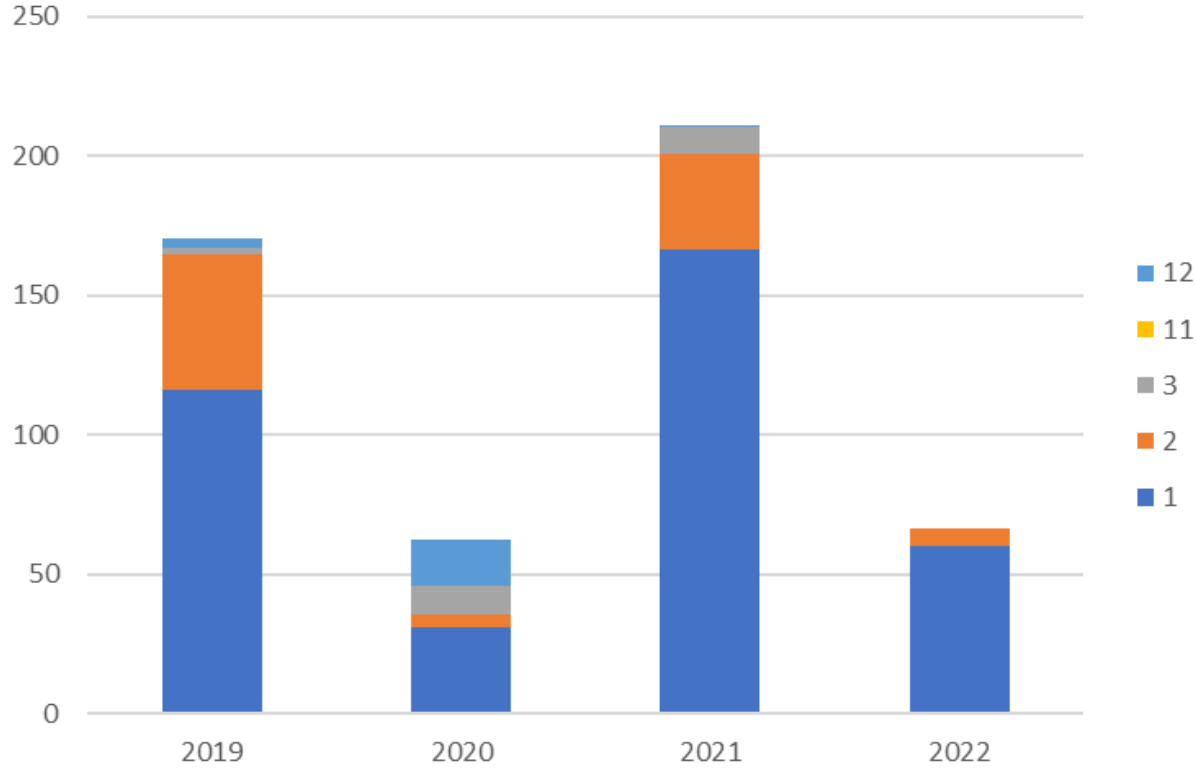

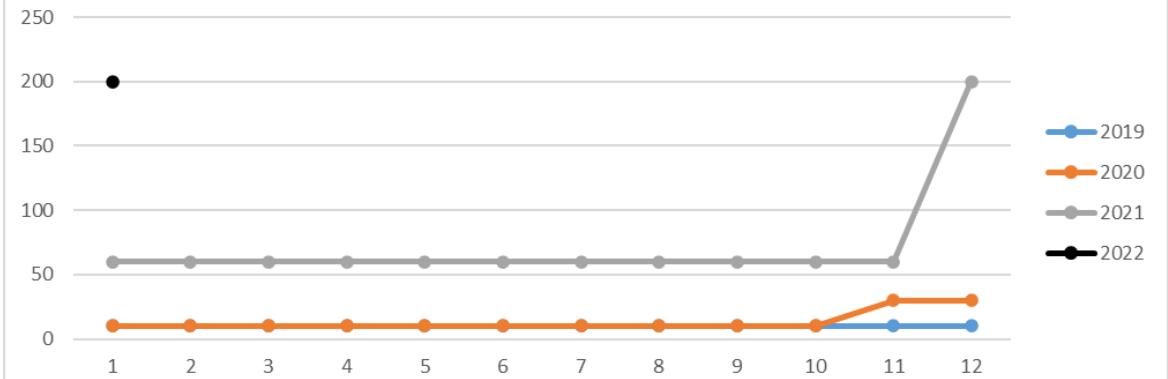
