#### 1. Chair Welcome & Introductions

#### 2. Quota Presentation (Edward Baker)

Question regarding allocation of additional quota to the ring-net fleet.

Edward Baker response this is a matter for the POs to decide how they support the ring-netters in their membership.

UK landings of 7e Sole are potentially not going to match the TAC advice, why?

Some vessels switched target stocks this year (from sole to plaice).

Many inshore vessels did not target this stock until summer this year.

Question from Cornish FPO – could there be some flex from 7e into 7h.

Carl O'Brien response - CEFAS are looking into this.

7fg Sole is hard to target in the inshore due to abundance of spider crabs which has increased in recent years. Window for targeting sole without spider crabs has reduced to September/October-March.

Question about whether banking mechanism will remain in place?

Paul Harvey answered that banking will remain the same as previous years and, as normal, some stocks will be exempt.

#### 3. Cornwall IFCA update on Crustacean Management Plan – Samantha Davis, IFCA

CIFICA are working to develop a Crustacean Fisheries Management Plan and are looking for responses to their questionnaire regarding topics such as max/min landing size and effort management. The questionnaire went out to permit holders 3 weeks ago; the closing date is 15<sup>th</sup> Oct.

CIFCA are looking for volunteers to for a stakeholder group to assist with the development of this. If interested, get in touch with Colin Trundle.

#### 4. Small Eye Ray in Area 7e - Jim Ellis, CEFAS

Currently no quota for this stock. An indicator of stock size is needed to progress development of a quota for this stock. Specifically looking for fishers from St. Austell to Portland.

#### 5. <u>National Representatives – Lydia Osborne, DEFRA</u>

We are looking for representatives from this group to attend a national RFG meeting. They would need to attend to meetings online and then feed back to the wider RFG.

The purpose of the national meeting is to bring together the regions a few times a year to provide a platform to distribute messages about policy of national interest. We have only held one since disbanding the Inshore Working Group so we'll be looking to hold one again in next few months. The purpose and definition of these meetings can still be moulded by the RFGs.

Thoughts from the group:

- Need more like 3-4 reps to ensure full group opinions are covered.
- Do you need a rep, why can't everyone attend? Perhaps people could just listen in?
- There is a lack of industry reps now as the industry has shrunk over the years and Fisherman's Associations have disbanded.
- Very hard to enter the fishing industry (very hard to buy boats/quota) and we need to support
  young fishermen, if we support young fishermen to join then there would be more available
  to be a rep.
- The rep for the group may depend on the agenda of the national meeting.
- The national meeting should be recorded and posted online.
- Suggested that we need to persevere with the inshore working group as there will be issues such as non-quota stocks that effect all groups.

**ACTION** – RFG team to investigate: Suggested that there could be a knowledge sharing slot in these meetings where members of other RFGs share their developments.

#### 6. Community Quota Schemes - Paul Harvey, DEFRA

The aim is to pilot is a new process/management approach for fisheries in England. They are looking for ideas from you on how this should work, what can be learned from the current system, and what should be done differently. #### **Capped licences**

Question regarding whether capped licences could be un-capped? And suggestion that if a licence were un-capped there could be a ban on aggregating the licence.

Andy Carrol stated that Capped licences would be reviewed by DEFRA next year as part of a wider licencing review.

#### **Bass**

Request for bass management to be on the agenda for next meeting. Industry wants to be involved in the development of new bass measures.

It was highlighted that non-powered vessels (kayaks) are 'free' to land as much bass as they like.

Bass permit transfers to vessels with larger KW/tonnages than the originating vessel has caused contention as this was previously banned.

Question as to whether capped licences could extend to bass?

Andy Carroll said he would update.

ACTION – include bass management discussion in next meeting and invite Lewis White from DEFRA.
