3. MMO Grants – Michael Johnson, MMO - Fisheries and Seafood Scheme (FaSS)

FaSS - Designed by Defra administered by MMO financial support for projects in England across a number of sectors.

5. Collaborative Science - Jim Ellis, Cefas

Small Eye Ray

CEFAS, Jim Ellis informed that the Endeavor surveys are too deep and won't catch them. At it's shallowest it reaches 18m which is not shallow enough.

Acknowledged presence of Small Eye in Start Bay.

Industry - small boats can't fish certain areas because there's so many Small-Eye. Many people would welcome working with Cefas to investigvate .

6. Introduction to Fisheries Management Plans (FMPs) – Jon Davies

Government requirement to publish list of intended Fisheries Management Plans within 2 years of Fishereis Act entering into force.

Considering different types of FMPS e.g. stock or species specific, groups of stocks, or sea areas and types of fisheries.

RFGs will get chance to input into the development of FMPs. Industry have the opportunuity to put proposals for FMPs to government.

This was needed and a positive move.

Amount won't be a problem towards end of year for trawlers, but would like an increase if possible. POs will always trade out if they can.
