IV HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the consignment of meat and/or meat products described above meets the following conditions:

- (a) it was derived from animals which were born and reared in *the United Kingdom (England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland) *and/*or *the Republic of Ireland and have been resident since birth or for a minimum period of 12 months prior to slaughter;
- (b) the animals from which the meat was derived originated from zones or regions free from rinderpest and foot and mouth disease;
- (c) the animals were processed in establishments free of pests and diseases to which the species is susceptible;

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- (d) the animals from which the meat was derived were examined ante-mortem and post mortem under the supervision of an Official Veterinarian. No clinical evidence of infectious or contagious disease was observed and the meat was found fit for human consumption;
- (e) the animals were slaughtered and the meat processed, cut and boned in approved establishments in accordance with hygiene legislation currently in force in the United Kingdom;
- (f) the meat and packages of meat referred to above bear a UK or GB health mark indicating that it has been obtained, handled and stored in accordance with UK hygiene regulations and continues to be wholesome and fit for human consumption;
- (g) to the best of my knowledge and belief, the meat has been produced, handled, stored and transported within the United Kingdom in such a way as to prevent contact with any animal products not meeting the requirements of this certificate.

Additional Declarations

- (h) The animal products described above comply with the relevant United Kingdom animal health/public health standards and requirements;
- (i) The product(s) described above does not contain and is not derived from bovine, ovine and caprine materials other than those derived from animals born, continuously reared and slaughtered in the United Kingdom and/or Republic of Ireland and which has been produced in full compliance with retained Regulation (EC) No. 999/2001 (as amended).
