JUDGMENT

1. The claim for an unlawful deduction from wages is well-founded, but the sum outstanding was paid on 26 January 2022. There being no further loss arising from the unlawful deduction there is no compensation payable.
2. The claim that the respondent failed to provide the claimant with payslips for November and December 2021 and a P45 is well-founded. The tribunal makes a declaration to that effect pursuant to sections 11 and 12 of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
