## JUDGMENT

- 1. This is the judgment on the claimant's pay claims, judgment for a protective award having been made previously and sent to the parties on 21 January 2022.
- 2. The claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of notice pay succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the balance of her notice pay owed after a capped payment was made by the Redundancy Payments Service. The sum outstanding to be paid by the respondent is £8,305.48. This is the gross figure. Payment of the net sum may be made provided tax and national insurance are properly accounted for.
- 3. The claimant's claim for arrears of pay succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £484.37 in respect of arrears of pay owing for the period 1 April to 14 April 2020, after capped payments by the Redundancy Payments Service and the administrators of the respondent. This is the gross figure. Payment of the net sum may be made provided tax and national insurance are properly accounted for.
