JUDGMENT

1. This is the judgment on the claimant's pay claims, judgment for a protective award having been made previously and sent to the parties on 21 January 2022.
2. The claimant's claim for breach of contract succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £14,462 as damages for breach of notice requirement. This is in respect of the balance of damages for failure to give notice, after a capped payment was made by the Redundancy Payments Service.
3. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £2,416.58 in respect of non-payment of wages for the period from 1 to 15 April 2020, after a capped payment was made on behalf of the administrators of the respondent.
4. The claimant's claim for pay for untaken holiday succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1,250 in respect of 5 days accrued but untaken holiday.
5. The figures given are the gross figures. Payment of the net sum may be made provided that tax and national insurance are properly accounted for.
