JUDGMENT

- 1. This is the judgment on the claimant's pay claims, judgment for a protective award having been made previously and sent to the parties on 21 January 2022.
- The claimant's claim for breach of contract succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £14,462 as damages for breach of notice requirement. This is in respect of the balance of damages for failure to give notice, after a capped payment was made by the Redundancy Payments Service.
- 3. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £2,416.58 in respect of non-payment of wages for the period from 1 to 15 April 2020, after a capped payment was made on behalf of the administrators of the respondent.
- 4. The claimant's claim for pay for untaken holiday succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1,250 in respect of 5 days accrued but untaken holiday.
- 5. The figures given are the gross figures. Payment of the net sum may be made provided that tax and national insurance are properly accounted for.
