School Improvement:

- AB members raised questions on the school improvement models of Rainbow and St Barnabas MATs and their understanding of the impact that the additional schools joining them will bring
- Rainbow MAT have been preparing to grow and created additional capacity to support this growth.
- St Barnabas also has focused on capacity and the track record to support growth within their leadership team.

Finance:

- AB members commented on the levels of financial reserve in St Barnabas MAT
- An ESFA official said they are working with the trust to bring reserves in line with ESFA expectations

Governance:

- AB members questioned the diversity of experience within the Rainbow MAT board and the level of commercial expertise
- This will be discussed with the trust and an external review of governance was recommended

- AB members queried the lack of trustee background and skills that are published on the St Barnabas MAT website. It was confirmed that this has been discussed with the trust and will be updated.
