JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous decision of the Tribunal that:

- 1 The Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 2 The Claimant's claim of victimisation relating to alleged detriments falling on or before 25 February 2020 was presented outside the statutory time limit.
- 3 The Claimant's dismissal was not victimisation under section 27 of the Equality Act 2020.
- 4 The Claimant's victimisation claim is dismissed.
