JUDGMENT

Corrected under Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure rule 69

- 1. This is the judgment on the claimant's pay claims, judgment for a protective award having been made previously and sent to the parties on 21 January 2022.
- 2. The claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of notice succeeds. The first respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £25,000 as damages for failure to give notice. This is in respect of the balance of damages for failure to give notice, after a capped payment was made by the Redundancy Payments Service. The amount is limited by paragraph 10 of the Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction Order 1994 which limits the payment which an employment tribunal can order in respect of complaints of breach of contract.
- 3. The claimant's claim for holiday pay fails and is dismissed.
