JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By letters dated 25 May 2021 and 4 April 2022 the Tribunal warned the claimant that it was considering striking out the claim because it was not being actively pursued. Specifically, the claimant had failed to respond to the Tribunal's letter of 5 January 2021, nor otherwise sought to actively pursue the claim through the Tribunal.

2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing as to why this should not be done or to request a hearing, despite having a reasonable opportunity to do so. The letter of 4 April 2022 invited a response by 18 April 2022. Nearly 3 months after that deadline, no response has been received. There is no evidence on file of the claimant having taken any active steps in the pursuit of the claim through the Tribunal since it was presented in November 2020.

3. The claim is therefore struck out under Rule 37(1)(d) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure.
