JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deduction of wages is well founded. The Respondent has made an unlawful deduction from the Claimant's wages and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the net sum of £1,800.23, in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the further sum of £103.83 in respect of financial loss attributable to the unlawful deduction from wages, pursuant to section 24(2) Employment Rights Act 1996.
