# JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that

- (1) The claim for unlawful deduction of wages is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant **£5,769.20** less any deductions for tax and national insurance.
- (2) The claim for breach of contract in relation to reimbursement of travel expenses is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant **£241.63**.
- (3) The claim for holiday pay is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£576.92** less any deductions for tax and national insurance.
- (4) The claim for breach of contract in relation to reimbursement of laptop costs is not well founded and is dismissed.

- (5) The claim for automatic unfair dismissal for asserting a statutory right is withdrawn by the claimant and is dismissed.
