JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages (training fees and exam fee) and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of £1754.45 in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.
2. The deductions in respect of the purchase of PPE clothing in the sum of £147.74 and car cleaning costs in the sum of £20 were authorised deductions. The claims in respect of these deductions are dismissed.
