JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1.1 The Employment Tribunal, in accordance with Rule 64 of the Employment Tribunal (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, Schedule 1 issues the following Judgment of consent of parties:
 - a) By not later than 4pm on 15 August 2022, the respondent shall pay to the claimant, Ms. E Asante, into the bank account of the claimant held on record by the respondent the following sums namely:

- Compensation for the claimant's breach of contract (notice pay) in the sum of FORTY-EIGHT POUNDS (£48.00) from which tax and national insurance requires to be deducted, provided that the respondent intimates any such deductions in writing to the claimant and remits the sum deducted to Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs.
- j) Compensation for the claimant's unlawful deduction of wages claim (wage arrears relating to work carried out on 13 January 2022) in the sum of SIXTY-TWO POUNDS AND SEVENTY-TWO PENCE (£62.72) from which tax and national insurance requires to be deducted, provided that the respondent intimates any such deductions in writing to the claimant and remits the sum deducted to Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs.
