## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages is dismissed having been withdrawn by the claimant.
2. The claimant's claim for unpaid accrued holiday pay is dismissed having been withdrawn by the claimant.
3. The claimant's claim for wrongful dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
4. The respondent is to pay to the claimant a sum of £82.28 in relation to the successful wrongful dismissal claim. This is a gross figure from which the respondent should make deductions for tax and National Insurance as appropriate.
