JUDGMENT

- 1. The name of the Respondent is amended to 'Uber Brittania Ltd'.
- 2. The Claimant's application to amend his grounds to include a claim of indirect discrimination against the Respondent is refused.
- 3. The preliminary issues identified within the Tribunal's letter of 30 June 2022 and the Respondent's letter of 27 June 2022 are resolved as follows:
 - a. The Claimant was not an employee of the Respondent within the meaning of s230 (1) or (2) of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
 - b. The Claimant is a worker in accordance with s230 (3) of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and in line with the decision in *Uber B.V & Others V Aslam & Others [2021] UKSC 5*.
 - c. Accordingly, the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider the Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal under s94 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and the claim is struck out.
