JUDGMENT

The part of the claim alleging unfair dismissal is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that it has no reasonable prospect of success in terms of rule 37(1)(a).

REASONS

1. On 28 February 2022, the claimant was informed that an Employment Judge was not able to issue a judgment for unfair dismissal as the claimant did not have the 2 years' service required to make such a claim.

- 2. On 1 March 2022, the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 11 March 2022 or to request a hearing in order to consider why that part of the claim should not be struck out
- 3. On 7 March 2022, the claimant wrote to the Tribunal and confirmed that he agreed that the unfair dismissal claim should be struck out. The Tribunal therefore strikes out that part of the claim.
