Instructions for Use

Groundcrew Mission Specific Software Loads - MOD Form 703B PT2(Puma HC Mk2)

- 1. MOD Form 703B PT2 (Puma HC Mk2) is used to indicate to the pilot the identity of any classified data fills undertaken by the groundcrew.
- 2. MOD Forms 703B PT2 (Puma HC Mk2) are to be inserted/removed from the MOD Form 700C in accordance with the instructions for controlled forms on MOD Form 799/1.
- 3. On carrying out a data fill, the Maintenance supervisor is to ensure that the MOD Form 703B PT2 (Puma HC Mk2) is completed as follows:
 - a. Date/SNOW. Enter the date and SNOW of the MOD Form 707A, if applicable, raised to document the data fill.
 - b. **Program.** Enter the appropriate program number for the system as applicable.
 - c. Classification. Enter the security classification of the current data fill for each system.
- 4. The last entry should reflect the current security classification of the systems listed and the program number for the current fill. The program and classification fields for those systems that are not classified are to have a diagonal line drawn through them.

Example: Aircraft loaded with Talon1 and Talon2 software. No other mission software loads fitted.
