JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim that there were unauthorised deductions from his wages with regard to under payment of wages for the period January to December 2019 is out of time and the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear this claim.
- 2. The Claimant's claim that there were unauthorised deductions from his wages with regard to deductions from furlough payments between March to September 2020 is well founded.
- 3. For unlawful deductions the Tribunal awarded the sum of £842.82 (net) being the sums deducted. The Tribunal also awarded the sum of £178.30 for consequential financial losses.
- 4. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay is not well founded.
- 5. The Claimant's claim for notice pay is not well founded.
