## JUDGMENT

- 1. The following parts of the claim are struck out under rule 37 of the Rules of Procedure on the grounds that they have no reasonable prospect of success:
  - 1.1 Bullying (save to the extent that this may be an aspect of the complaint of harassment).
  - 1.2 Defamation.
  - 1.3 Fraud.
  - 1.4 Corruption.
  - 1.5 Breach of rights.
  - 1.6 Breach of contract.
  - 1.7 Abuse of position.
  - 1.8 The claim for the remedy of dismissal from employment of various individuals.
- 2. The Respondent's application to strike out the remaining parts of the claim, namely the complaints of detriment for making a protected disclosure (known as "whistleblowing"); victimisation; harassment; and direct discrimination; are adjourned part-heard. The hearing will continue at 2 pm on 24 October 2022 before Employment Judge Glennie.
