I am writing to object to the proposal by Statera to construct a solar farm on 177 acres of land at Berden Hall Farm.

The reason for my objection is as follows:

- We should keep this prime farmland for crops.
- Solar 'farms' do not need to be built in the countryside, they can be built on roof panels, like they do in Germany.
- The country lanes are too fragile for the traffic that will come through for construction.
- Industry should not be built in the middle of the countryside, we should rather preserve it.
- Uttlesford already has enough ground mounted solar power for 132% of their households.
