**OBJECTION to Crabb's Lane BESS: Application numbers 3/22/0806/FUL (East Herts) and UTT/22/1203/FUL (Uttlesford)**

I am writing to record my objection to the application by Renewable Connections for permission to build and operate a Battery Energy Storage System at land off Crabb's Lane Stocking Pelham because the negative impact on this historic environment.

Crabb's Green Farm is a listed building. As the paddock (the proposed site for the development) is owned and associated with Crabb's Green Farm the site is within the curtilage of a listed building and should require listed building consent.

There are several other Grade 2 listed properties within 200 meters of this site including White Hart Farm, The Brooder House, Silver Birches, Longcroft, Bennils, The Old Rectory and Cockswood.

An industrial barn of the sort and size proposed is not appropriate within the curtilage of a listed buildings.

The proposed development is likely to be visible from the grounds of White Hart Farm in winter. No views from White Hart Farm have been submitted as part of the visual impact assessment.
