I am writing to object to the proposal by Statera to construct a solar farm on 177 acres of land at Berden Hall Farm.

My name is Ross Thurley. [REDACTED]

The reason for my objection is as follows:

As a local resident I frequently walk along these footpaths which will now be surrounded by solar panels and bordered by fencing. I do not want to walk along a corridor!

The views along this road will be hugely negatively impacted by the construction of huge numbers of solar panels and the associated infrastructure.

The visual impact of such a huge solar farm would fundamentally change the character of the area.

In view of the current war in Ukraine I believe strongly that we should grow as much of our own food and this development will use prime farming land. This is not, in my opinion, a sensible idea.

I strongly object to this application.
