JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed contrary to section 98 Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 2. It is just and equitable to reduce the compensatory award by 30% to reflect the chances of the respondent dismissing the claimant fairly in any event
- 3. The claimant was not automatically dismissed for a reason connected with a transfer pursuant to Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006.
- 4. The respondent did not discriminate against the claimant because of his age pursuant to section 13 Equality Act 2010.
- 5. The respondent did not breach the claimant's contract of employment by failing to pay him wages.

6. The respondent shall pay the claimant a compensatory award of £29,173.46 as compensation for unfair dismissal. This is the grand total due to the claimant under this judgment

- 7. The amount of the prescribed element is £21,950.03.
- 8. The period of the prescribed element is 3.1.21 to 18.8.22 inclusive.
- 9. The excess of the grand total over the prescribed element is £7,223.43.
