Could you confirm if any requests for funding have now been submitted (and / or approved) by Bournemouth Churches Housing Association Limited (BCHA) in relation to purchasing of property within Yeovil, most specifically the purchase of 166 Hendford Hill (also Known as Acacia Lodge), Yeovil, BA20 2RG

Response

We can confirm that Homes England does not hold the information detailed in your request.

To conclude that the information is not held, we have searched with our Affordable Housing Grants team who would have the requested information if held.

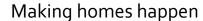
The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty under section 1(1) is only to provide the recorded information held.

Advice and Assistance

We have a duty to provide advice and assistance in accordance with Section 16 of the FOIA. To comply with this duty we are able to confirm that no new requests for funding have been submitted by BCHA in relation to purchasing of properties in Yeovil. We can further advise that the bid to the Affordable Homes Programme 2021-





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2026 was submitted on 30th September and was withdrawn on 29th November 2021 by BCHA for Acacia Lodge. The bid was withdrawn before any 'approval' process began.

Right to Appeal

You may also complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) however, the Information Commissioner does usually expect the internal review procedure to be exhausted in the first instance.
