 Regional Director provided an update on the transition to the new Regions Group, key priorities in the region and area-based commissioning discussions currently taking place.

Converter Academy Orders

Points discussed in relation to school conversion.

Project: Discussion to consider All Saints Catholic College, Kirklees, to convert and join Blessed Peter Snow Catholic Academy Trust.

AB discussion:

- The board agreed the trust would need to reset internal capacity to review risk management.
- SRMA to be deployed to support the trust to uncover any financial risks.

Project: Discussion to consider St Johns, Southworth RC Primary School, Lancashire, to convert and join Romero Catholic Academy Trust

AB discussion:

- The board agreed that this is a sensible proposal, however they shared concerns regarding the trust's central services.
- AMSD representative provided assurances that the SRMA findings will identify any financial issues which would be followed-up.

Project: Discussion to consider Gayton Primary School, Wirral, to convert and join Cheshire Academies Trust

- The board shared concerns regarding the trust's geographical reach and lack of performative evidence on schools which currently exist within the trust.
- The board agreed to defer the project and for the following actions to be completed:
 - Regional Director's office to organise conversation with the trust to discuss their growth plans
 - Trust to provide a robust growth plan of their current model
 - SRMA to be deployed
