JUDGMENT

The complaint that the Respondent has failed to pay a redundancy payment is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The Claimant complains of failure to pay the redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 163 and 177 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a Claimant to have not less than two years' service to make a complaint for unpaid redundancy.
- 3. The Claimant was employed by the Respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore, the Claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The Claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint of failure to pay a redundancy payment is struck out. The Claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
