## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- On 10 November 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 24 November 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- This followed earlier emails seeking information as to progress made by the claimant in seeking consent of court to proceed. Such consent is necessary

given liquidation of the respondent company. The claimant did not reply to any of the emails seeking that information from her.

The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
