JUDGMENT

Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013

No response has been presented to this claim and an Employment Judge has decided to issue the following judgment on the available material under rule 21:

- 1 The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £197.04, being 24 hours @ £8.21 per hour for 4 hours work per day over 6 days between 16 and 21 March 2020.
- 2 Further, the respondent has made another unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages and is also ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £34.88, being 4 hours @ £8.72 per hour for 7 April 2020.
- 3 Accordingly, the respondent is ordered to pay the total sum of **£231.92** to the claimant.
- 4 The claimant has insufficient qualifying service to claim for a redundancy payment, having been employed by the respondent for less than two years, and so that part of her claim is dismissed by the Tribunal.
