JUDGMENT

REASONS

- 1 On 26 July 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 4 August 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- 2 On the 18 August 2020 the claimant sought an extension to respond which was granted and a response was due by the 7 September.
- 3 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
