I am writing to object to the above planning. The infrastructure will be unable to support this planned construction. There are already traffic problems, and the volume of traffic through Elsenham, Stansted and surrounding villages is becoming ridiculous. The parking issues along that very stretch of road at a school pick up and drop off is very dangerous as it is, this coupled with works vehicles currently coming from Hall Road onto Henham Road (all day long) to the other building of 350 houses almost opposite, it is becoming a very busy and blocked. People use this as a main road into and out of Henham/Elsenham and Stansted for schools in Bishops Stortford, Stansted and Saffron Walden - this road has craters in it and I can assure you things will only get worse with Winter approaching. There are always problems with flooding. Wildlife is being eroded.

The doctors, dentists are already struggling to keep up with demand for appointments from existing villagers and with the additional 350 houses being built the local infrastructure is just not equipped and is likely not to cope should any more housing be approved!
