JUDGMENT Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013

No response has been presented to this claim and an Employment Judge has decided to issue the following judgment on the available material under rule 21:

- 1 The claimant was unfairly dismissed and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £14,698 by way of compensation. This is made up of a basic award of £2,223 (9 years employment x £247 weekly wage) and a compensatory award of £12,475 (a year's salary and £250 for loss of statutory rights); and
- 2 The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £243.20 in this respect.
