I am writing to object to the proposal by Statera to construct a solar farm on 177 acres of land at Berden Hall Farm.

The reason for my objection is as follows:

I believe that it is utterly inappropriate to use agricultural land for solar panels. It does not support the environment or our options for growth of food which is significantly more important.

I do not understand the lack of joined up thinking when there are countless roofs without panels that could be much more appropriately utilised. I have discussed with the council the option to place solar panels on my own roof, but apparently being in a conservation area solar panels are not permitted, which makes no sense at all by comparison to the Berden Hall Farm (Pelham Solar) application!

Viable rolling agricultural land within a small and thriving village community that attracts such diverse nature needs to be used in support of nature and growth of food. Please do not ruin our natural environment.
