**OBJECTION to Barden Hall Solar Farm: Section 52A Planning Application
062A/22/0006 and UTT/22/2044/PCNS (Uttlesford)**

I am writing to record my objection to the application to construct a solar farm comprising ground mounted solar arrays plus inverter cabins, a substation, fencing and CCTV cameras on land near Ginn's Road, Barden because the negative impact on this historic environment.

National Planning policy requires that planning decisions should contribute to and enhance the natural and local environment by recognising the intrinsic character and beauty of the countryside, and the wider benefits from natural capital and ecosystem services - including the economic and other benefits of the best and most versatile agricultural land, and of trees and woodland.

If allowed to proceed, this development will have a hugely negative impact on the public's enjoyment of the area and will ruin the appreciation of the countryside vistas which are visible from many of the footpaths in the vicinity and, in particular from footpaths 21 and 26 which cross the site. The landscape should be preserved in its current state for future generations to enjoy.
