JUDGMENT

- 1. At the material times (31 March 2020 to 6 August 2021) the second claimant was disabled within the meaning of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010 by reason of pneumothorax (causing weak lungs) and benign paroxysmal positional vertigo (causing dizziness).
- 2. The respondent is ordered to pay £4,050 by way of contribution to the claimants' costs incurred in respect of the postponement on 26 August 2022 of the full merits hearing.
