## JUDGMENT UNDER RULE 21

1. The Claimant presented a claim against “Amazing Services Group” on 21 July 2022. Having checked companies house, the Tribunal has located a company called Amazing Services Group LTD with the same registered address. The judgment is therefore issued using that name.
2. The Respondent has failed to file an ET3 and Grounds of Resistance in this case.
3. Having considered the ET1, Employment Judge E Burns has decided that a determination of the claim can properly be made without a hearing and the Judgment of the Tribunal, made under rule 21 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, is as set out below.
4. The Respondent has unlawfully failed to pay wages, holiday pay and notice pay to the Claimant.
5. The Tribunal orders the Respondent to pay to the Claimant:
  - a. Unpaid wages of £1433.50
  - b. Holiday pay of £235.45
  - c. Notice pay of £322.10
6. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the total of **£1991.05** and to account to HMRC for any tax and NI due on this sum.
7. **The hearing on 28 September 2022 is vacated and the parties should not attend.**
